

# 2007 Riverside Bluesfest Vendors

## Rules and Regulations

- 1.) Vendor fees shall be \$250 for Open Air Food Vendors and \$100 for non-food Commercial Vendors located in the Commercial tent.
  - A.) Open air food vendors shall be defined as any vendor selling consumable items. Open Air Food Vendors shall be located in the area to be designated by the Bluesfest Committee.
  - B.) Commercial vendors shall be defined as any vendor selling non-consumable items and/or distributing information/advertising. Commercial Vendors shall be located in the Commercial Tent in spaces designated by the Bluesfest Committee.
- 2.) Open Air Food Vendor space shall not exceed 30 ft. sq. unless arrangements have been made in advance with the Bluesfest Committee. Commercial Vendor space shall not exceed 10 ft. sq. unless arrangements have been made in advance with the Bluesfest Committee.
- 3.) No alcoholic beverages shall be sold by any vendor. All carbonated beverages and bottled water to be sold must be obtained through the Bluesfest Committee based on event sponsorship. Any specialty beverages made on site, and not in competition with event sponsor shall be permitted based on approval from the Bluesfest Committee.
- 4.) Electrical access will be available -- 220 volt service available upon request. Water will not be made available to individual vendor areas. Water and potable water will be available at several locations in the park, but must be transported to individual vendor areas for use.
- 5.) Vendors shall be responsible for all lighting, furnishings, and any structures necessary for their operations.
- 6.) Grills, open air fires and other means of cooking are subject to inspection by the St. Marys City Fire Department.
- 7.) Vendors are responsible for keeping their areas neat and clean. Place all trash in plastic bags (provided). Dumpsters will be provided in designated areas.
- 8.) Vendors shall operate as a minimum from 12 p.m. through 11 p.m. on Saturday Sept. 1, 2007.
- 9.) Vendors operating in confined structures are required to have a fire extinguisher with current inspection. Vendors using deep fryers will be required to have an approved K-type fire extinguisher, per City of St. Marys codes. All licences and permits required by the Ohio Department of Agriculture and/or Auglaize County Health Department are the sole responsibility of the vendor. All laws and regulations issued by those agencies must be obeyed.
- 10.) No vendor shall sell/distribute/promote anything not listed with or previously approved by the Bluesfest Committee. All items must be cleared by the vendor chairperson. Any vendor selling/distributing/promoting items not listed on their contract will be asked to vacate the premises.
